1) As a group, make a list of as many aspects of Jesus' identity as you possibly can. What aspects of Jesus' identity do you think you see more clearly? Which ones do you think you might be blind to, and how would you know?

2) What comes to mind when you think of the "ordinary means" by which Jesus engages through? How does the truth that Jesus supernaturally engages us through these ordinary means affect you (meaning how does it make you feel)?
